Directions:

From the TTC:

The nearest subway station is Wilson Ave. Take a bus going west on Wilson Ave. to Keele Street. Walk 300m south. Building is located on east side of Keele Street.

From the West:

Take 401 East, exit at Keele street, turn left on Keele street, building will be on the right.

From the East:

Take 401 West, exit at Keele street, continue on Keele street north, building will be on the right.

Parking:

Parking is available around the perimeter of the Medical Centre. An additional parking lot is accessible off Wilson Ave., east of Keele, on the south side via Cactus Car wash driveway entrance. You may also find parking at Metro Plaza (north west corner of Keele street and Wilson ave.), or at Tim Hortons Plaza (south west corner of Keele street and Wilson ave.)
