WHAT IS KRIYA YOGA

Kriya Yoga is an ancient method of living and meditation that cultivates body, mind, intellect, and awareness of the soul using powerful meditative and yoga disciplines. It helps us to experience the three divine qualities of light, vibration and sound by using techniques of concentration, posture and breathing. This develops a onepointed mind, which enables us to penetrate the deepest levels of consciousness and to change our lives. Kriya Yoga teaches that any action, kri, is done by ya, the indwelling soul. It is a universal spiritual discipline that crosses all divisions and boundaries.



Paramahamsa Hariharananda (1907-2002) - (photo on the right), filled with purity and love, came from a long, unbroken line of masters, ultimately attaining, Nirvikalpa Samadhi, the highest goal of a realized yogi. A disciple of Swami Shriyukteshwarji and Paramahamsa Yoganandaji, he spread Kriya Yoga to the
