Information about the seminar June 2-13, 2021

Due to Corona requirements, we regret that we are unable to offer neither in-house accommodation nor meals. Please find here a list of accommodation in the area.

The number of participants who can be present in the meditation room at the same time is limited to a maximum of 50 people. The **meditation room is all seated** and meditations take place on chairs only. Unfortunately, the grounds of the Kriya Yoga Centre <u>are accessible only during the scheduled event times.</u>

- FFP2 masks are compulsory on the premises of the Kriya Yoga Centre indoor and outdoor.
- Social distancing: 2 metres
- Drink (please bring your own water bottle)

Event blocks and daily seminar schedule:

11.00 a.m. - 12.30 p.m. Meditation (guided by an Acharya) **followed by Darshan** (with Baba Prajnananandaji) **18.00 - 20.00 hrs Darshan** (with Baba Prajnananandaji) **and meditation** (led by an Acharya) **Optional "Walks with Acharyas"** - to be announced on site.

Block A - 2-7 June: Seminar starts on 2 June with evening programme and ends on 7 June with evening programme (FULLY BOOKED!)

Block B - 8-13 June: Seminar starts on 8 June with lunch programme and ends on 13 June with the lunch programme (THERE ARE ONLY A FEW PLACES LEFT)

Seminar price: (please pay cash on site)

1 event block (noon or evening): € 17,-

2 event blocks (noon and evening): € 35,-

(unless one cancels at least 24 hours before the start of the event, all booked blocks shall be paid for)

Admission approx. 1 hour before the start of the event.

Registration at the entrance and check of a negative test result, proof of vaccination (from 22nd day after first vaccination) or proof of recovery from a Covid 19 disease within the last 6 months.

Rapid antigen test in one of the test lanes is valid for 48 hours, everyone can be tested again and again free of charge after registering once at https://www.testung.at/anmeldung/ with the same registration number - test lanes in the district of Baden (Attention: test lane Tattendorf is closed on 3.6.) The test result is sent to the cell phone or can be viewed on the test page. Please always have your test number ready. The test is also required for the guesthouse/accommodation.

Self-tests brought along can also be carried out under control at the entrance

- however, these are **only valid on site for that day.**

Please note: if you test positive, you will of course be subject to quarantine in Austria. (Notification under tel. 1450 at the health authority).

Participation in the seminar is not possible

- * for persons who have symptoms of an infectious disease, cold/cough or fever.
- * for persons who have been in contact with a Covid-19 infected person, or if since the last contact with an infected person, or if 14 days have not passed since the last contact with an infected person.
- * for persons who are subject to any other quarantine measure.

Entry into Austria

From almost all countries (currently except the Netherlands, Sweden, France partially), entry is possible without quarantine for tested, recovered (within 6 months) or vaccinated persons (from 22nd day after first vaccination).
